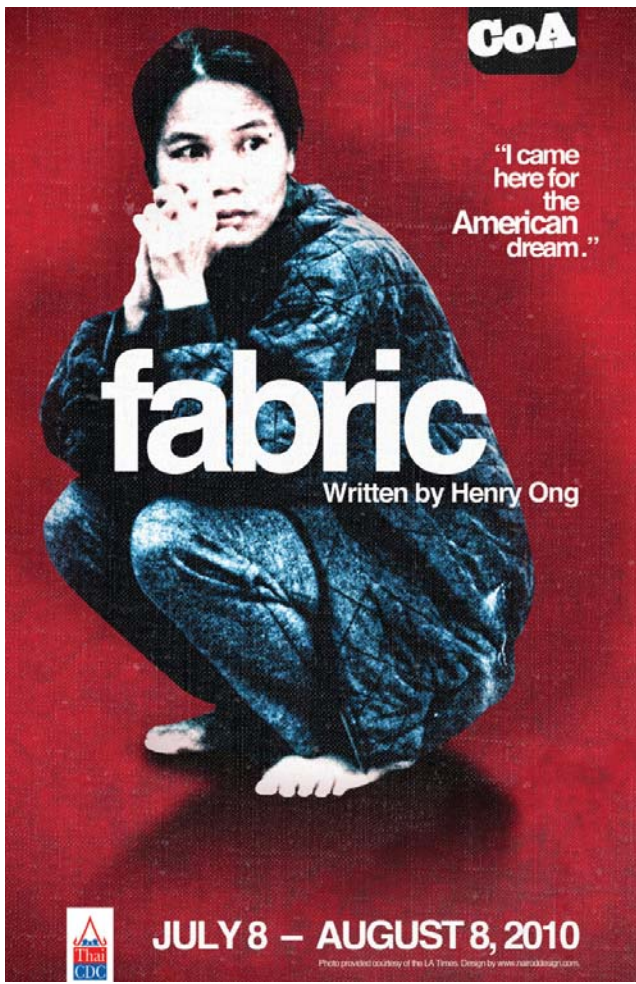

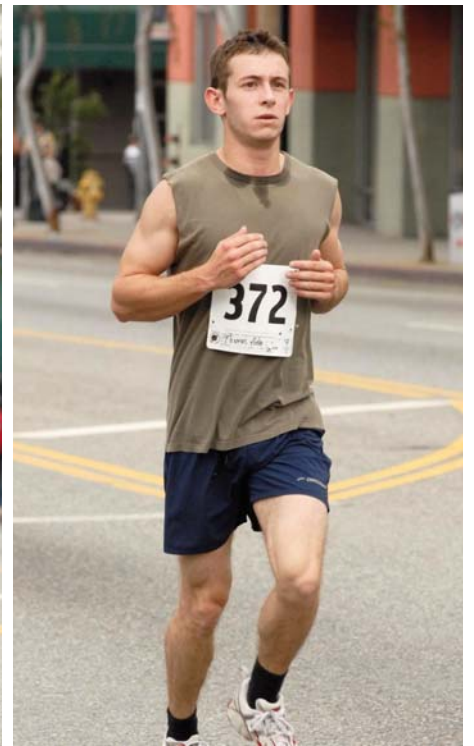

## Lodging at the World Famous MADONNA INN Friday thru Sunday - 8/13-8/15

**\$65 per person per night (1, 2, or 3 nights)**

If you have never stayed at the Madonna Inn, you're in for a treat. Each of the 110 rooms is decorated with a special theme (one of our rooms is Oriental Fantasy and yes, Bernie is included), there's a Day Spa, two kitschy restaurants including an all pink steakhouse, and is just minutes from downtown San Luis Obispo. Check the website and click on the rooms to see what it's like - the Caveman Room, for example, features rock walls, floor and ceiling, and a waterfall for a shower.

## Montana de Oro Trail Race Sunday, August 15 8K/12K/25K/50K

Montaña de Oro, "Mountain of Gold", features 7 miles of shoreline, rugged cliffs, sandy beaches, coastal plains, streams, canyons, and hills, including 1,347-foot Valencia Peak. This race is put on by the Pacific Coast Trail Runs folks, who do the Sycamore Canyon/SM Mountain races we do in the spring and fall. This is a LAFR Grand Prix and TrailMaster Series race.

### Tour 1 - The Experience Tour

Tour One is recommended for first-timers as it provides a broad overview of Hearst Castle and includes the film "Hearst Castle: Building the Dream" shown on our giant 5 story screen in the Hearst Castle Theater. The main stop on Tour 1 is the main house (Casa Grande). Rooms on this tour include: the Assembly Room, the Refectory, the Morning Room, & the Billiard Room.

### Tour 2 - Upper Floors of Casa Grande

Tour Two focuses on the architectural elements and vast art collection in the main house, or Casa Grande. Featured rooms on this tour include; the Doge's Suite, "The Cloisters" which are four guest rooms flanked by open walkways, the Library, the Gothic Suite which occupies the entire third floor and includes Hearst's impressive private suite, library & office, & the Kitchen.

### Tour 3 - North Wing of Casa Grande

Tour Three provides an overview of the construction and development of the Hilltop by contrasting the earliest guest house with the most recent addition, the North Wing. Tour 3 includes the 1940s bathrooms in the North Wing, the North Terrace, and Casa del Monte, one of the Hearst's magnificent guest houses.

### Tour 4 - The Garden Tour

Tour Four not only concentrates on the beauty of the botanical gardens, but also provides a glimpse into some of the less familiar aspects of Hearst Castle. Tour 4 includes the Wine Cellar of Hearst Castle, featuring rare European vintages and California wines and Casa del Mar where Hearst himself spent his final years of residence on the hilltop.
