Race Report: Ric Munoz

Ric did more racing during two weeks of April than most of us will do the entire year. Ric spent the weekend of 4/2 in North Carolina running his latest 100-mile race. Here is what he had to say about it: "I am pleased to report it was my personal best by nearly 21/2 hours. My finish time was 25 hours 10 minutes – my previous best was 27 hours 35 minutes (in a race in Riverside last year). On Feb. 26/27, I ran a gruesome 33 hours. 9 minutes in a 100-miler down in Coto de Caza (Orange County) so the Umstead race was a big confidence booster."

The race was held in Raleigh, entirely within Umstead State Park (near the Raleigh-Durham airport). The course was 121/2 miles long and runners had to run 8 laps of it to cover the 100 miles. Ric began running at 6:00 Saturday morning and finished at 7:10 on Sunday morning.

Two weeks later, Ric hit the start line of his 17th Boston Marathon w/ 9 other LAFRs and ran a 3:23:10.
