# LAFR Silver Lake Stairs Run/Walk Saturday, October 9, 8:00 AM

Join us on Saturday, October 9th for our 2nd Annual "LAFR Stair Run", only this time we'll be running all the #@&\*! stairs of Silver Lake! There are 40 public staircases in Silver Lake (sadly, two are now closed off) ranging from the easy, 5step Rotary staircase to the thigh-busting, 154-step Landa staircase. Along the way well pass a variety of L.A. landmarks such as the 132-step "Music Box" stairs used in a 1932 Laurel and Hardy movie (yes, we'll be running up those too), the 22,000 sq. ft. 




